Dear Prayer Partner,

Christians in Action is looking for fifty-seven missionary couples to serve around the world. Another goal is to open new works in Asia. The movement has begun as one couple has been trained and sent, and another is close to going to their field. The first couple arrived in South America in July.

Now that we have moved to Portland, Oregon, we are in the ideal climate to participate in the move toward these goals. Churches are mission minded and want to raise up ten thousand missionaries from the Northwest through mission organizations. One lady we are getting to know said, "I'm new to all this. I'm looking to you for information and guidance in missions."

We have moved into the condo in Portland. As we approached the Oregon border while driving to Portland from Woodlake, we stopped at a little wooden store in the mountains to fill the gas tank. I went inside to get the owner to activate the pump. The one customer ahead of me asked the owner for a carton of cigarettes. With that she stated, "I really need to stop smoking." Looking at her, I said, "Why not pray and ask God to help you?" "Oh, I should do that," she said. The owner interjected, "That won't do any good," but the woman continued talking. She believed that prayer would help because she is a recovered alcoholic and had seen what God can do.

Every time we said something positive, the owner tried to counteract it. The woman left, saying, "I do need to pray!" After pumping the gas, I came back inside to pay and told the owner how God had healed me from asthma. "Oh, that's nice," she said curtly. Here are two people with very different reactions, yet God can work in both hearts.

Please pray:

- that the Lord will guide us in setting up ministry as we learn what's happening here and how we fit in.
- for opportunities to meet those who are considering serving in missions and assist them in finding God's place of service.
- that God will raise up fifty-five more missionary couples to serve in Europe, Asia, and South America. (We'll take more if He so leads.)
- for the couple newly-arrived in South America, and the couple who expects to leave soon for their field.
- that the Lord will work in the lives of the two women I met at the store in California.
- for God's wisdom and grace for us in all things.
