### Medical Missionary Intensive

April 11-22, 2010, Marion, North Carolina, those are the dates and that is the place where one of the most intense medical courses took over my life. Can you imagine learning how to make and use nasal/gastric tubes? How about learning how to do this to try to save a life so that maybe that person can decide to have a personal friendship with the God of the universe? How about learning how to suture, deep and shallow? Now if your 3 year old got cut on a rock, a stick, or anything else and there was no physician unless you trekked out of the jungle, carrying her for a number of days, would you try to sew her up yourself to try to save her life? That is just two of the many things I learned while spending time in Marion, NC.

The course offers missionaries the basic medical knowledge of diagnosing and treating tropical and common diseases no longer seen in the United States. It also teaches basic emergency lifesaving procedures, and other things like giving immunizations, drawing blood, and the list goes on. This knowledge does not take the place of seeing a trained physician but in a pinch it might just save a life, in a third world country. (Not for use in USA!!)

So I spent my days, 6am to about 1am, listening, practicing, studying, and doing case studies, one after another, not much time for sleep. ☺ Hopefully I will never have to use the knowledge I gained but I am glad I had the opportunity to learn.
