About 45 minutes into a 3-hour hike he painfully realized he'd forgotten the census forms. Via his cell phone he arranged to meet someone part way with the forms. At one point on the return

he saw a small boat fighting to reach shore. Due to the 8 foot waves they ran the risk of capsizing and had a sick child who needed to get to the hospital. Anael is an excellent swimmer so was able to get the little one safely to shore as well as the mother who couldn't swim. I wonder how often our interruptions really are appointments orchestrated by the LORD to carry out a very specific plan.

Then there was the evening when Anael and his partner were returning from another



village and had to run for their lives. Four men started chasing them with machetes. At just the right instant headlights appeared and there was the Christian mayor, on an unlikely mountain road at an unlikely hour. Thank you, LORD!
