## MISSION TRIP TO GHANA: 14 – 20 JULY

Dear friends,

In just a little over a week I'll be traveling to Ghana to visit the ministry of CinA in this West African nation.

Christians in Action's ministry in Ghana is still fairly young (it was founded in 1994) and yet much has been done during that time. In cooperation with Campus Crusade we translated the Jesus Film into Twi (the local language) and have shown it in many towns and villages in the unreached areas in north Ghana. As a result about 14 churches have been planted which are all led by national pastors.

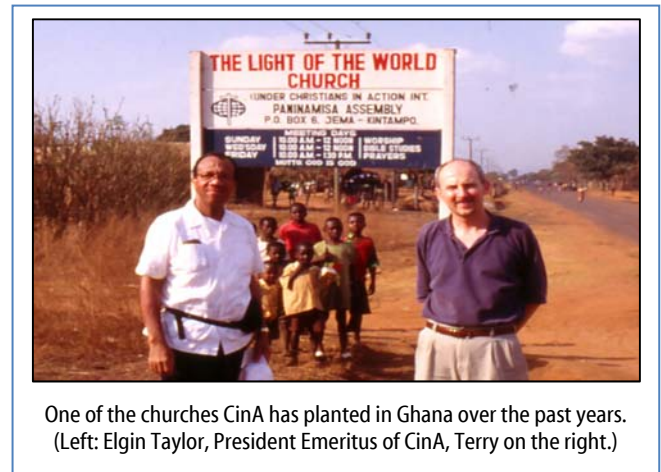
In addition to our church planting ministry CinA has also started 3 primary schools and drilled 11 wells to help meet the practical needs of the people.

I visited Ghana several times a few years ago (see photo). During this trip I want to re-establish a good working relationship with the team there in my new role as International Director. I sum up that role with this simple phrase: "Doing my best to help others reach their full potential in what God has called them to be and to do." Please pray that I'll really be able to do this during my time in Ghana.

During this trip I'll also accompany a new missionary to Ghana, Susie Taylor, and help her get established. She plans to start a vocational program to teach rural women sewing skills.

Here's my basic schedule:

- July 14: Arrive in Accra, Ghana
- July 15: Meet with the Secretary of Water Works to discuss future well drilling projects.
- July 15: Travel up country to northern Ghana.
- July 16: Meet with the team leader.
- July 17: Meet with leadership team.
- July 18: Preach in a local church service, then in a large evangelistic crusade that evening.
- July 19: Conduct a Pastors seminar.
- July 20: Return to Germany.
